The successful applicant will be responsible for managing and carrying out all aspects of crop research trials at Atlantic AgriTech Inc. Specific tasks will include

- Interpreting and following protocols, frequent communication with clients, data collection and statistical analysis and final report completion and submission
- Layout, planting, maintenance and harvest of small plot research trials on a variety of crops, including operation of all small plot research equipment (tractors, seeders, harvesters, sprayers, etc)
- Interaction with grower-cooperators for experimental sites,
- Product calculations and applications, sample collection, trial documentation and equipment operation as per our Standard Operating Procedures,
- Maintenance of farm and research equipment including tractors, plot combine, field attachments, sprayers, etc.
- Collaboration with Research Coordinator and summer students to conduct field research activities.

The successful applicant must have previous experience operating and maintaining farm equipment common to Eastern Canada, and should be very comfortable and confident doing so. The candidate must also be mechanically inclined and be able to keep equipment maintained and in good working condition as well as perform small repairs when necessary. The successful applicant must be detailed oriented, a good communicator, a hard worker, and ambitious, and be willing and able to work individually and as part of a team. A valid driver's license is also a requirement.

The following experience and qualifications would be considered an asset:

- Bsc. or Diploma in Plant Science or related field
- Crop research related experience, as well as experience handling pesticides and fertilizers
- Pesticide applicators license
- Basic competency with tools of all sorts
- Ability to handle multiple assignments in a fast-paced environment

The job will require outdoor work as well as some work beyond normal working hours, so the successful candidate must be able to work extended hours when necessary. Some early mornings, evenings, and weekends will be required, especially during the growing season.
